Let's hear how he experienced his studies at Hasselt University as a distance learning student, combining work and studies.

# Why did you applied to enroll in the Master of Transportation Sciences by distance learning?

Three years ago, I took the decision and applied for the Master of Transportation Sciences by distance learning at Hasselt University. I have been working at a motorway management centre in Greece since 2009 but I felt that something was missing. What was that? The knowledge of course. I was really experienced on motorway management issues but I felt that I needed to go and search deeper on my work. During all these years I have been taught about different modes of transport, human behavior, transport planning etc., things that are really important and helped me to become more efficient in my work. The university helped me a lot with problem solving situations and made me think about things in a different, more scientific way.

What I would like to emphasize is Hasselt University's contribution on professionals' creation. It is known that most universities prepare students by teaching them all the theoretical aspects of a specific subject. Hasselt gives you the opportunity to work on it. The internship is really important for a student to understand not only the theoretical aspects but also the practical aspects of his work. Hasselt creates professionals and this is the most important thing. This is why Hasselt stands out in relation to other universities. Internship helps students apply knowledge in an autonomous and self-managing manner, help them to adapt and work in a multidisciplinary environment, and make them more professional. This is the reason why I chose Hasselt, even if in my case the experience exists. Hasselt opened my view according to my job. This is the greatest achievement. If I had to choose a university again, Hasselt would be my first choice.

#### What do you think about the content of the master programme at Hasselt University?
